



Oakmere Pay & Play membership.

Gives you all the benefits of membership including the option to have a handicap and play in Club competitions, no restrictions on times of play, advanced tee time bookings. Ideal for golfers who play regularly but not enough to justify the benefits of unlimited golf with full 5 or 7 day membership.

The Cost of Oakmere Pay & Play membership.

Only £250 for 500pts.

How does this work?

Either course, weekdays, weekends and times of day have different pts value when you play (See table below). If you use up your £250 during the membership year you can top back up with a further 500 pts for £250 at anytime. Any points not used at the end of the membership year (31st October) can be rolled over on condition that you renew your membership on 1st November and your new points will be added to any points remaining. If you do not renew, then your points will be lost.

If you find that your playing more regularly than you previously planned you can always upgrade again to Full membership at any time.

Benefits and conditions of Membership.

- If you pay an additional annual fee of £18.50 you are able to play in Admirals or Commanders weekly Club competitions although Individual comp entry fees will be payable and also have an
- EGU affiliated handicap.
- Members discount card available to be used around the complex giving you up to 30% off food & drink.
- Able to book up to 14 days in advance for either course
- No Tee time restrictions.
- All Pay & Play memberships expire on 31st October each year.
- Any unused points credit will rollover to following year if membership is renewed on 1st November.
- Top up points available at £250 for 500pts at any time.
